

Charity Race to Benefit
180 Turning Lives Around

Host Club: Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club

Location: AHYC Olympic Circle on Sandy Hook Bay

Eligibility: The AHYC Ms. Race is open to sailing yachts with a valid 2020 PHRF-MA rating certificate

and to yachts that race one design. Skipper and all crew must be female.

Type of Race: Pursuit start (boats start in order based on PHRF ratings – slower boats start

earlier than faster boats).

Divisions: All PHRF yachts will race NON-Spinnaker. The race must have at least 3 boats registered to

count. One design fleets will be accommodated with a 3-boat minimum. Class rules apply.

Date/Time: Saturday, August 22, 2020

1300 hrs - START for first boat

1900 hrs - 2000 hrs - Virtual Awards Ceremony & Presentation of Trophy via zoom

Virtual Fundraiser Aug 15 to Aug 22 17:00 hrs

Virtual Captain's Meeting & Sailing Seminar via zoom Friday, Aug 21 19:00 hrs

Entry Due: August 20, 2020 19:00 hrs

Stay the Course

A tribute to her niece on a milestone birthday inspired this year's Ms. Race

It began as a haiku, *Stay the Course*, written to my niece on her birthday: "You must stay the course, Challenges will line your path, Stay strong and focused". It was my message to her as she enters the tumultuous teen years, when things can go off course. The term signifies staying on track for your goals or destination regardless of the obstacles, but it has become more of a daily call during these challenging times.

This year the unprecedented changes to our daily lives forced us to step back and reassess how we would continue as individuals and as a society. We have seen both the negative and positive sides of radical change happening in a short period of time. There have been terrible stories of loss and suffering that break our hearts, but then there are the people who continue to do amazing things to help their communities in the face of adversity that give us hope. Amidst the flood of news stories we read about a nurse who sailed up from Virginia with other medical staff to live onboard and volunteer at NYU. If you are a sailor you can appreciate the logistics of the journey they had to make, but it was the selflessness of that group of people to help out at the epicenter of the crisis that was so moving.

After considering the logistics and new safety protocols, the Ms. Race Committee decided that regardless of the obstacles, we would work to raise funds for 180 Turning Lives Around. Initially we were not sure if we would be able to host a regatta event and we soon realized that most of our campaign would be virtual events. Many of us have had our fill of video chats and calls, but on the flip side we have seen such a wave of creativity flow from people that previously were not using these platforms for communication. The stream of humorous, beautiful and artistic expressions from people everywhere has given us hope, relief and sometimes much needed laughter.

We felt "Stay the Course" was the appropriate theme for this year's campaign and we decided to try new events to help raise funds for 180 because the current crisis presented even greater challenges in raising funds and helping victims of domestic violence and rape in our community. Recently we hosted a virtual Ladies Night with an exceptional panel of women from the sailing community on a national, regional and local level. Difficult topics of Racism, Bias, Inclusion and Domestic Violence were discussed and the women relayed how these topics affected their personal and sailing lives. We gained greater insight into these issues because these speakers were willing to share their stories. Without the online platform, we may never have had the chance to gather all of the panelists in one evening for discussion.

We look forward to hosting all of the teams for our 16th Annual Ms. Race Charity Regatta and we thank them for returning year after year to support this event. We will continue to work hard to reach our goals for 180, to support our sailing community, and keep the lines of communication open at a time when people really need to reach out to each other. Stay strong, stay focused, stay the course.




